We shall review the needs of the community in line with the Covid restrictions in Spring 2022.

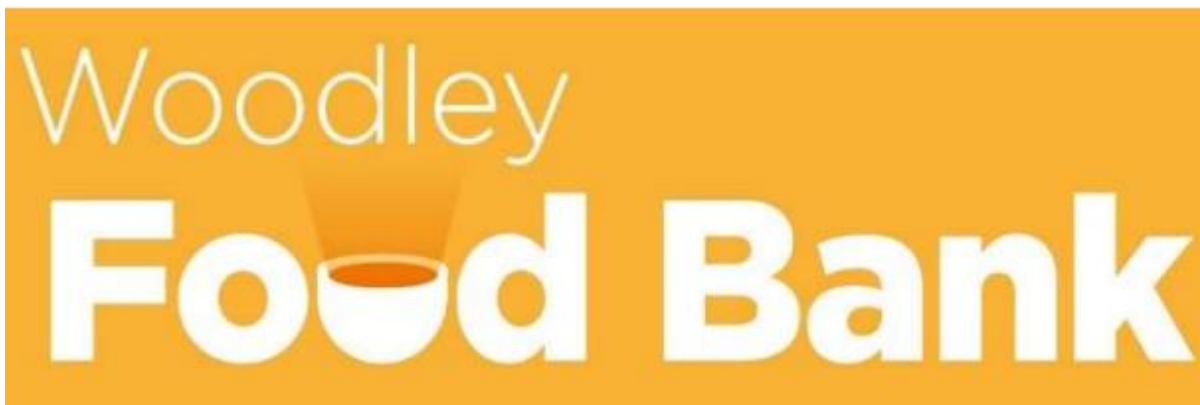
