2 Samuel 22:2-3

Dear Friend,

In John's gospel, Jesus tells us that He is the light of the world; and in the Sermon on the Mount, He says,

"You are the light of the world ...
let your light shine before others,
so that they may see your good works
and give glory to your Father in heaven."

Put simply, we are to reflect the light that is Christ in our lives; we are to be a beacon for God in all that we do; we are called to shine God's light into the darkness of the world.

William Booth, founder of the Salvation Army, believed that this was the duty of all Christians. In his very last public address, he said,

"While women weep, as they do now, I'll fight;
while little children go hungry, as they do now,
I'll fight; while men go to prison, in and out, in
and out, as they do now, I'll fight; while there
is a drunkard left, while there is a poor lost
girl upon the streets, while there remains one
dark soul without the light of God, I'll fight."

Are we as willing as William Booth, and countless other Christians throughout the ages, to fight so that others might come to know Jesus, and see the light of God in their lives?
