Dear Friend,

As we enter October we are all reflecting upon what it means to be British following the referendum about independence that was recently held in Scotland. We are also caught up in a maelstrom of discussions about who has authority, or right, to govern whom.

In the midst of all this we do well to remind ourselves of the Kingdom that we belong to, and of who has all authority. For while we are resident in this world, our citizenship, as Paul reminds us in his letter to the church in Philippi, "is in heaven"; and the One who reigns in heaven is the same Jesus Christ who died for everyone. He told His disciples that, "All authority has been given to me in heaven and on earth". We honour this authority by continuing to worship and serve Him in our lives.
